Sample Run of Show

Saturday Event

- Thursday/Friday truck and staff arrive
- Friday night setup (~4 hours)
 - Can be as late as necessary due to pool availability
- Saturday
 - 6/7am-8am final setup
 - 8am-10am wave 1
 - 10am-12pm wave 2
 - 12pm -1pm lunch break for staff and volunteers
 - 1pm-3pm wave 3
 - 3pm-5pm wave 4
 - 5pm-10pm breakdown and pack up
- Saturday night or Sunday morning truck and staff depart

^{*}Specific time slots can be adjusted. The sample above is merely meant to show the length of time needed for setup, event waves and teardown.

Cost Structure

Each event has a specific "partnership cost". Following the event, if that figure has not been met by registration fees, the host club/facility will owe USA Swimming the difference. However, if the registration fees exceed the cost, the club/facility will receive a check for the "profit. The partnership fees are not owed by the club ahead of the event – they are simply taken into consideration in the post-event reconciliation.

A deposit of \$2,500 is due within three weeks of signing a contract. This is the only upfront money needed to host the event. The deposit ensures our staff can book flights/hotel and shipping for the course can be reserved. The deposit is returned to the club following the event.

SwimJitsu - \$12,500

2-Day SwimJitsu - \$15,600 (efficiencies for the second day based on lack of shipping/additional travel for staff)

Case Study: Washington DC

May 21, 2016

SwimJitsu Lite

- Charged \$25 (\$5 more than the suggested amount)
- \$4,325 in profit
- 21 new leads
- 21% 8 and under
- 28% 9 and 10
- 28% 11 and 12
- 70% on a team
- 30% not on a team





Case Study: New Providence, NJ

June 11, 2016

SwimJitsu

- 486 Participants
- Sold out event
- \$5,940 in profit
- 21 new leads
- 20% 8 and under
- 28% 9 and 10
- 30% 11 and 12





Case Study: Cypress, TX

Sept 24, 2016

2-Day SwimJitsu

- Charged \$35 (\$5 more than the suggested amount)
- \$8,121 in profit
- 37 new leads
- 24% 8 and under
- 27% 9 and 10
- 25% 11 and 12
- 64% on a team
- 36% not on the team





Case Study: Greensboro, NC

May 28-29, 2016

2-Day SwimJitsu

- Event held on Memorial Day weekend
- 341 participants (of possible 960)
- Loss of \$6,270 (due to 2 day structure – breakeven point of \$15,600)
- 27% 9 and 10
- 25% 11 and 12
- 20% 13 and 14
- 76% on a team
- 24% not on the team
